CRUISER IN LIMELIGHT

TIMBER CRUISER ACCUSED OF VIOLATING THE LAW.

Brought before Magistrate Charged With Issuing No Fund Checks.

Charges of obtaining money under false pretense, the pretense in this case being the issuing of no fund checks on banks in Baker City, have been preferred against Timber Cruiser R. B. Wasson, by David Brischoux, and Wasson's case came up for trial before Justice Williams at three o'clock this afternoon.

The charge is made that Wasson issued checks on banks in Baker City when it is alleged, there are no funds to check against. Several have been caught by these efforts to pay debts, according to current rumors. Mr. Brischoux says he was paid \$5.00 in check form by Wasson and discovered later that there are no funds. The arrest followed.
