DIVIDEND MONEY IDLE

DEPOSITORS SLOW IN RECOVERING THEIR CHECKS.

Less than One-Third of the recent Appropriation Has Been Removed as Yet.

La Grande doesn't appreciate good cash. Approximately \$20,000 in dividend money lies in the vaults of the receiver's office of the Farmers & Traders National bank, awaiting calls from the owners. Receiver Niedner hoped to give the depositors a liberal Christmas present of a ten percent dividend, but the depositors don't seem to be in need of the money just now, even this Christmas holidays.

The incident has two phases. One is that the records will be slow in a cleanup if the depositors do not remove the checks. Only one-third or less has been removed.

Another phase is that the city is not begging for money. While the financial crimp was sharp for a time the depositors soon recovered from it and now have got to the point where this particular money is not needed in the daily routine of business. Regardless of whether the money is needed by the depositors at this time, it should be removed at once. The receiver's certificate of deposit is all that is necessary to secure the cash.

WATER FLOWS VERY FREELY

LESS THAN HALF CAPACITY NOW IN PIPE LINE

Caretake Propeck has Optimistic Report from Beaver Creek.

Ed Propeck, who is stationed at the intake of the Beaver Creek city water supply, walked in over the line yesterday and started back this morning but will not reach his destination until tomorrow evening.

He states that Beaver Creek is frozen over at the present time but there is plenty of water. He has the gate open only one turn, a full head means 28 turns. Mr. Propeck is of the opinion that during the heaviest point of the irrigation season 15 turns will give us all the water that this city will need for some years to come.

At present the telephone wire is out of repair and it is possible that it will not be fixed up until spring. Mrs. Propeck is with him and they are enjoying their winter quarters quite well.

Mr. Propeck is of the opinion that within a few years, at most, the city will utilize the poker which this pipe line will produce for either manufacturing or lighting purposes.
