More profitable than all the other branches of industry is fruit growing, where the conditions are right—and they are right in Union county. But like the most of the good things of life, there are the "drawbacks." The drawbacks to fruit raising are chiefly in having to wait for from three to five years for a profitable crop, while an orchard is maturing or in having to pay what a bearing orchard is worth, if one buys an orchard fully matured.

Measured by the selling prices of orchard lands, improved and unimproved in other tried districts that have been proven good, the fruit lands of Union county are absurdly cheap, and it is inevitable that the prices will double and triple within a very few years. This prediction is justified by the fact that there are no fruits produced in the Pacific States

It is difficult to estimate the profits per acre realized by fruit growers, excepting within wide limits; the results depend so largely on the individual. An ordinary, well-kept orchard, though, does not return less than \$300 an acre a year, and in exceptional cases acre profits reach to \$1000 and \$1500. In any event, five acres is a liberal support for a family, and ten acres all that one can conveniently care for. Such profits make fruit land prices of \$75 to \$150 an acre, and bearing orchards at \$200 to \$800 an acre look like snaps and are. But they will not last long and those who get in on the ground early are looked for a long profit in the end, whether they hold or resell.

Fruit growers of Union county produce also peaches, plums, peach plums, pears, prunes, berries of all kinds and other varieties of tree and vine fruits. Irrigation is not required, but where it is available it is freely used. The growers who irrigate contend that it is an advantage; and those who do not contend that it is not. Certainly, wisely used, irrigation is a benefit on any land, though there are few irrigated districts that produce fruit equal to the non-irrigated fruits of Union county. 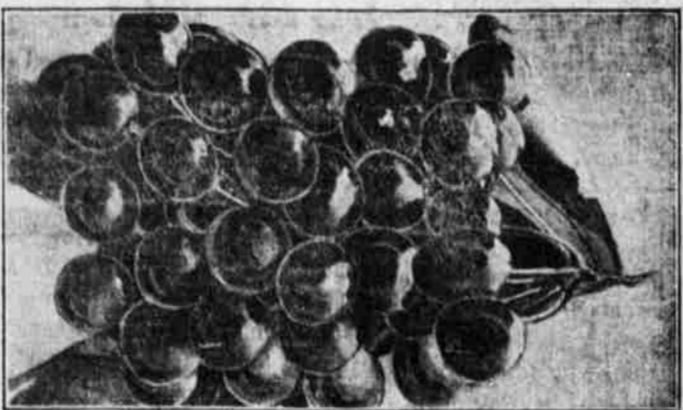
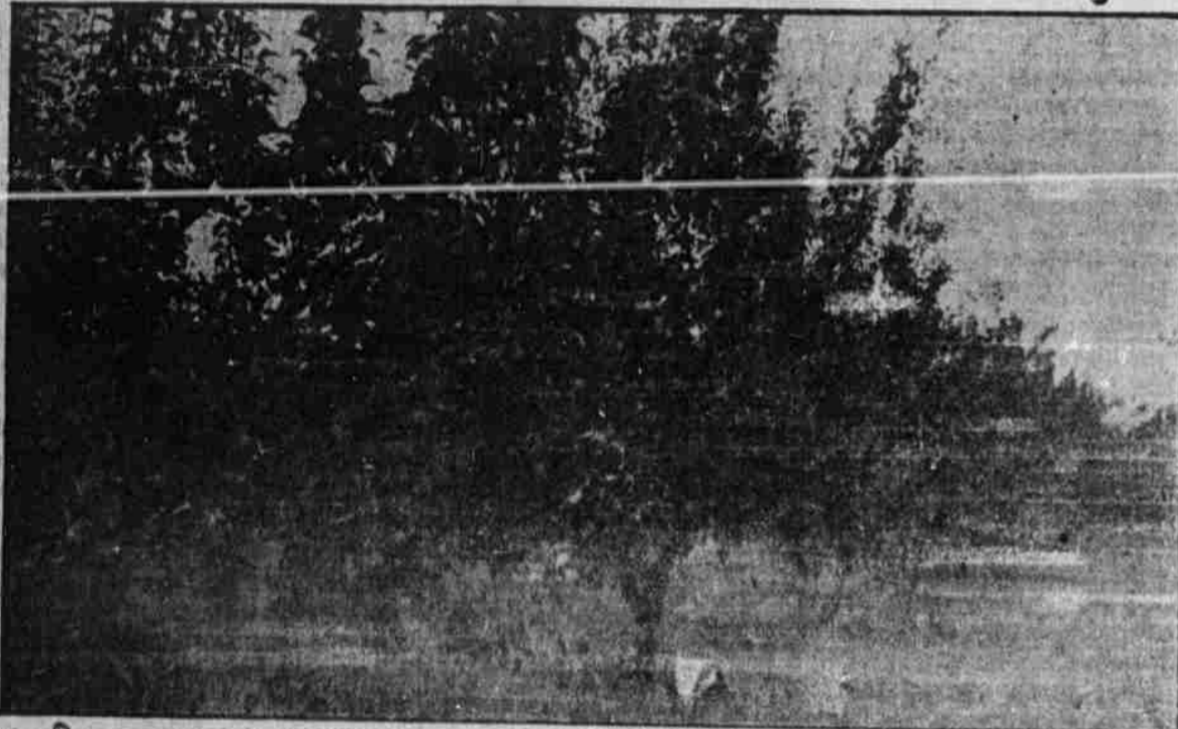
