Radical changes in the passenger and mail train services on the O. R. & N. go into effect tomorrow morning. The official time table is now in the hands of the La Grande officials

and the new changes can be ascertained definitely. No. 11, the fast mail, changes numbers and has a duplicate running east, which heretofore has not been a fact. These two trains stop at Baker City and La Grande but at no other places on this division and run on exceptionally fast time.

In the local train service La Grande loses some of its former service. No. 6 which arrived early previously, comes later in the day and its time is taken by the new East bound fast mail. The official time table is published above, and takes effect tomorrow morning. The Joseph

La Grande trains will run as before. Local routine business supercedes the unusual in the yards this week. Few engines are in for more than ordinary repairs and all the unusual excitement prevalent is the new engines.

Engine 30, the Umarella switch engine, has yet about ten days of work to be done to it before it will be ready for service.

Engineer Lute Ferguson is on a lay off.

There is coal enough in the yards to meet all immediate demands and officials are not worrying much over the coal supply.
