BUILDING ERA IS COMING QUICKLY

SNODGRASS RESIDENCE AND TAILOR SHOP UNDER WAY

Year's building activities will be larger than ever before

Nineteen hundred and ten building activities are now getting under way and before the year is out, one of the greatest building eras in the history of the city will be witnessed. Even at this early date, workmen are busy. Jas. G. Snodgrass has already commenced the foundation of his fine residence, corner first and Washington. This building is just opposite the new Shea structure and with the Lunn brick house to go up within a block of these two houses, that portion of West La Grande is rapidly becoming a fashionable residence district.

Contractor J. J. Clancey is improving his property on First St. between Main and Washington with the construction of a large front porch.

Workmen are progressing with the Bohnenkamp repairs rapidly. This particular improvement is one of the many extensive projects on foot this summer. North La Grande, too, is getting its share of buildings and lumber is being hauled to several sites of new homes.

Addition to Andrews & Berry establishment nearing finish.

Rogue River Pioneer

Captain Abel D. Helman, the last of the intrepid band of pioneers who first settled in the Rogue River valley and the real founder of the city of Ashland died at this home, Saturday, March 5, at the age of 86 years. Captain Helman was Ashland's first postmaster, holding the position for 27 years. He named the town after Ashland county, Ohio, his boyhood home. His residence was the second building to be erected there. He was prominent in Odd Fellowship and was ever a man of enviable standing in the valley. Eight children by his first wife and a widow by a later marriage survive him.

Hanford's Coming
