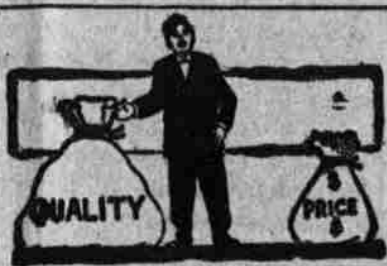

**SHEEP QUARANTINE IS NOW REMOVED**

**FIGHT AGAINST SHEEP SCAB IS VERY SUCCESSFUL**

Large areas in Northwest taken out of sheep quarantine tomorrow.

Washington, D. C., March 14.—(Special)—As a result of the efforts of the federal and state authorities to eradicate the disease known as sheep scab, an order has been issued by the Secretary of Agriculture, effective on March 15, releasing the entire state of Washington and large portions of Oregon, Nevada, Utah, Colorado and Arizona, as follows: That portion of Oregon lying east of the Cascade mountain; the counties of Lincoln, Clark and Nye, in the state of Nevada; the counties of Beaver, Piute, Iron, Garfield, San Juan, Washington and Kane, in the state of Utah; all of the territory of Arizona except Navajo and Apache counties, and all of the state of Colorado except the counties of Conejos, Rio Grande, Saguache, Huerfano, Castille, Las Animas, Baca, Bent, Prowers, and portions of the counties of Montezuma, La Plata, Archuleta, Pueblo, Otero and Kiowa. The release of so large an area at this time indicates the good progress made during the past year in stamping out this disease, which is a great handicap to the sheep industry.

When the Bureau of Animal Industry began systematic work more than ten years ago for the eradication of sheep scab this disease prevailed over large areas of the West and was rapidly spreading. Gradually the infection has been stamped out and the areas reduced until the territory now remaining under quarantine consists only of the states of Kentucky, Texas and California, the Territory of New Mexico, two counties in Arizona, the northern part of Utah and Nevada, and the Western portion of Oregon. The good results have been accomplished with the co-operation of the state and local authorities and the support of progressive stockmen.

**CAN'T SEE COMET.**

Disappears over the horizon too early in the day—Visible in few weeks

La Grande has but slim chances of getting a glimpse of Halley's comet until late in April for the traveler is rapidly nearing the sun's disc and because of the high hills sun-set-ward it is impossible to get a view of the comet after dark, for it disappears from view early. In Portland and Willamette Valley towns, it has been seen frequently. In a few weeks it will appear as the morning star, and then continue to grow brighter and more magnificent daily. A Portland savant says of the comet's appearance as seen from Portland:

"The comet is now approaching the sun very rapidly and will soon be lost altogether in the solar effulgence until it swings past and over the sun's disc and appears in the East as a morning star. The fact that the comet appears as a feeble central light, surrounded by neb-

lous matter, and that the latter is not yet elongated in the form of a tail is very apparent, as is accounted for by the fact that the comet is approaching us from space 'head on' its caudal part swinging back of it and is largely concealed behind the nucleus and the corona. This will be the case until the comet can be seen at a larger angle from the sun; that it, a greater elongation when it will present itself to us sideways at full length, once before its solar transit and again and much longer afterwards at its western elongation.
