TAXES COME FAST

Collection up to date indicate that money is plentiful

Indications are that there will be very few delinquent taxes for the present year.

In proportion to amount enrolled collection to date for the year 1910 exceed those of any past year. Approximately \$190,000 has already been turned in, and it is estimated that fully \$230,000 will be in by the fourth of April, after which taxes become delinquent.

This is an enrollment of \$290,000, an increase of \$50,000 over last year.

U. S. MINISTER ATTACKED

Domingo resident attacks Uncle Sam representative at Santo Domingo

Washington, March 17.—Horace O. Knowles, American minister to Santo Domingo, was assaulted by a man named Costello, a brother of the governor of the Province of Santo Domingo, according to dispatches received by the State Department today. It is stated the man was deranged. The Dominican government officials came to the American legation and expressed regret.

CHARGED WITH NEGLECT

Washington state is after the Great Northern for neglect

Olympia, March 17.—The Great Northern railway is liable to the state for \$48,000 for failure to provide a station building at Velvet, Stevens county, as ordered by the railway commission, in a suit on file here today. The state will demand only \$1000, the suit being to test the law. The law provides a penalty for \$250 damages for each day's failure to obey the law, which was issued last August.

DIG UP OLD FILES

Land office installs new filing case that brings up old letters

Documents that have lain in one place untouched, since the early sixties, when the land office was instituted here, were last night dusted out and placed in a modern filing case. There was a large volume of this sort of paper and much of it has lain for decades, unmolested.

It was a fine four year old Shorthorn cow weighing 1820 pounds, considered by local men to be the largest four year old in the county. On foot, it brought the owner over \$70.

GRAFT ON HALLEY'S COMET

Kieff, March 17.—Taking advantage of the ignorance and superstition of the Russian masses, swindlers in many parts of the empire are reaping a harvest in the shape of subscriptions for special prayers for the delivery of the world from the comet. In Kieff and vicinity the scare is general. It is suspected the police is getting its share, as there is no attempt to stop the frauds.

Greek Peasants Fight

Constantinople, March 17.—A serious clash between Greek peasants and troops in which many peasants were killed and wounded, occurred at Kardita, according to a censored dispatch from Athens today. The fight was the result of land riots.
