JOHNSON WARNS MEN

AFTERNOON MEETING AT TABERNACLE SUNDAY

"Whoever a man sows, that shall he also reap" is text.

At a special meeting for men in the tabernacle yesterday afternoon, Evangelist Johnson spoke from the text found in Galatians sixth chapter and seventh verse. "Be not deceived; God is not mocked; for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap."

He urged that all men, and especially the young men, remember this passage from God's divine word, and remember also that a man reapeth more than he sows.

As a man may raise a whole crop of grain from a handful of seed, so may a man reap a world of suffering from a handful of evil deeds. He mentioned the using of the church for unholy purposes, as a meeting place for friends, as a loafers resort, so to speak, where a man goes merely to be entertained, or to advance any other interest other than the worship of God.

Many people use the church as a step to advance business or social interests.

He stated that if the churches were no more good than this, gaining nothing for God, they should be burned down, and the ashes scattered, but if they were of good, and are worthy of saving souls, then they are worthy of all the benefit that our help, and manhood and courage can give them, and it should be given freely and gladly.

He spoke of the awful results of booze drinking, touching up the question from a moral and physical side in a way that was good to hear. He quoted statistics in support of the assertion that there is no pure beer made in this country, and has not been for over ten years. In answer to the statement sometimes heard that the saloons cannot be regulated by law he declared that the election of upright, Godfearing men to enforce the laws would do much good in this line, and that the men of the churches should stand behind the officers in the crusade for law and a proper handling of the traffic. For the benefit of those who cry that the saloons run wide open in spite of the law, he asked if a man would be willing to license a man to do murder, simply because there were murders committed in spite of the law.

All laws are broken at times, but this forms no ground for selling a privilege to break the law, as saloons are licensed to lead young men and women go down the slope to hell.

There was a good attendance and two conversations, making a total today of over 150 since the beginning of

the meetings.
