### TELESCOPE FOR COMET

LOCAL MEN BUY COSTLY INSTRUMENT FOR USE.

La Grande will be able to see comet before and after May 18.

La Grande people are to have the privilege of studying Halley's comet through a powerful telescope at a very nominal cost. The local professional and business men have organized a committee to purchase the instrument here in sufficient time to guarantee a magnificent view of the comet before it is visible to the naked eye. The instrument is over seven feet long and is brought here at a cost of more than \$1000, for which is furnished by the five men behind the movement. J. H. Childs, Perry Oliver, H. E. Coolidge, C. M. Humphries and T. J. Scroggin. The firm known as C. M. Humphries & Co.

The instrument will be mounted on the roof of some high building, perhaps, or may be placed out of doors where access is more convenient. These things are to be decided upon later, but it will afford, at any event, an opportunity of seeing the wonderful wanderer. It will be able to permit a study of it for several weeks after it has disappeared from the naked eye range, after May 18, when it is to be at its most brilliant stage.

Telegrams ordering the instrument were sent yesterday and it is believed that the instrument will reach here about next Tuesday. It is the best on the market.

### FREE FARM SEEDS.

All school children under 16 can have seeds free of charge.

Agricultural seeds, provided for the fair association here by the Portland Seed company, will be distributed free of charge by Will Church of the fair commission, to all children who want to enter the competitive production of agricultural products, for which liberal prizes will be offered at the county fair next fall. All children under 16 years of age who want to enter for this contest and be in running for the liberal prizes can secure seeds from Mr. Church by writing and telling him the kinds they want. As the fair commission is paying good money for the seeds, the members of it feel that they cannot distribute seeds indiscriminately or to people who will not enter the products of the seeds on the competitive shelves of the exhibit hall. The appropriation for seeds and prizes is to act as a stimulant for better grade of garden truck and farm products in general. It is a very important proposition and every school child under 16 who has the ground facilities should accept this opportunity to school themselves in progressive farming and incidentally, help the fair and aid themselves peculiarly.
