TEMPORARILY INSTRUMENTS ARE TO BE IN "HALL"

Change not to be made until building is moved back.

For 30 or 40 days the dispatcher's offices will be located in the Union county exhibit hall, adjoining the depot platform. This is to make room for carpenters who will renovate the second floor of the depot and make more modern office rooms there. The transfer from the present room, however, will not be made until the building is moved back to its permanent location, and Line Chief Tim Donovan is now erecting and perfecting a system of wires that will permit the continuous clicking of the instruments until the building is halted on its final resting place. For a brief period then, the entire system will have to stand still, a condition very rarely a fact.
