## MUCH DONE AT MEETING

COUNCIL ACTS ON MANY NEW  
ORDINANCES.

Important Matters Given Finishing  
Touches at Meeting Last Night.

Though the council last evening "knocked off" an hour earlier than usual and quit making laws at 11 o'clock, a large amount of routine matters were attended to.

The fire and police committee reported the old buildings in the rear of the Marx building as nuisances and ordered them removed at once.

Street committee reported favorably on petition for arc light at Adams and Greenwood. This and other arc lights will be installed as soon as they are available.

The street committee reported favorably on petition for a cross walk at Spring and Walnut streets.

Petition for arc light at Seventh and Pennsylvania, reported favorably by committee.

Petition for cross walk at Spruce and Washington favorably reported by committee.

A new petition asking for a four-inch main on North Spruce was laid upon the table until next meeting.

The ways and means committee asked for more time to decide on the matter of disposing of the pest house. Granted.

A list of streets and parts of streets to be sprinkled during the summer months, will be compiled by the street committee for the next meeting.

The matter of septic tank bids is still unfinished as the bid of the company represented by Engineer Kelsey was thought to be too high and bids from Portland are now being sought.

A proposition of making a dumping ground for garbage at the North end of Fourth street in the river just above the Proebstel bridge, is under consideration and will be acted on at a subsequent meeting.
