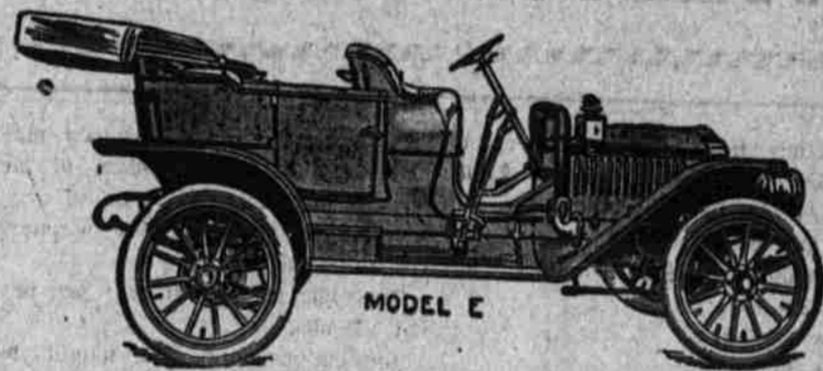
Culture Can't Be Forced Through Thick Skin Of Average American.
