NEW PLANT IS FINISHED

THOUGH IT HAS NO NAME CREAMERY IS READY.

All Machinery Tested and Found to be in Working Order and Ready

The plant was set in motion yesterday and all parts of the machinery have been thoroughly worked out. The concern will be ready to do business on a capacity scale within a day or two.

"Grande Ronde Creamery Company" was the cognomen first agreed upon but it was learned that this caption connected with others already existing and the matter is now up to the state officials who will give their sanction to suggested names as soon as possible.

The plant is housed in a remodeled structure on Fir street and wears a clean appearance, both exteriorly and interiorly. Manager B. W. Noyes and Buttermaker C. C. Clark have been busy today adjusting the various pieces of machinery and the plant now is ready to do business as soon as a name under which it will be operated is selected.
