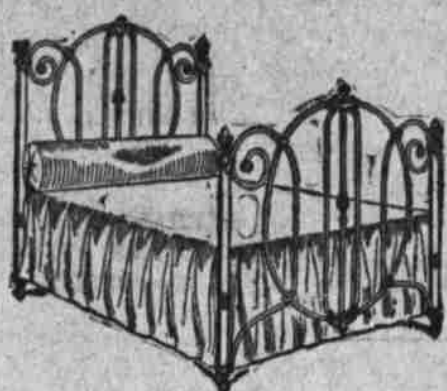

MEMORIAL DAY PLANS

SUNDAY AND MONDAY WILL SEE TRIBUTE GIVEN DEAD

C. E. Cochran Will Deliver Memorial Address Monday Afternoon

Many of the details attending unto decoration and memorial exercises in this city have been arranged, and while the programs have not been decided upon in full, there is enough to give the public a general outline of what the old soldiers are planning in honor of departed comrades.

The two-day exercises commence on Sunday when at 1:30 p. m. the G. A. R. and W. R. C. will meet at the G. A. R. hall and at 2:30 will go to the Central church where Rev. Ford Ellis will preach the memorial sermon. This will conclude the exercise for that day, but on Monday at 10 a. m. the G. A. R. and the W. R. C. will meet at the G. A. R. hall again and go to the cemetery to decorate the graves of the dead soldiers. At 2:30 p. m. the memorial services with the usual program will be carried out and Attorney C. E. Cochran will deliver the memorial address.

MOTHERS' DAY OBSERVANCE.

Aid Promised by Women For Starting General Uplift Movement.

Co-operation in the "mothers' day" program suggested by Governor Deneen of Illinois in his recent proclamation naming Sunday, May 8, is promised by the Illinois Congress of Mothers, 10,000 strong, and similar celebrations in other states are being urged by the 500,000 women connected with the national congress.

"By a general observance of a special day we hope to start a general uplift movement," said Mrs. Edgar A. Hall, publicity chairman of the national organization, the other day. "We now publish a monthly magazine called the Child's Welfare, and in it there is an appeal to all mothers to urge special sermons in all the churches.

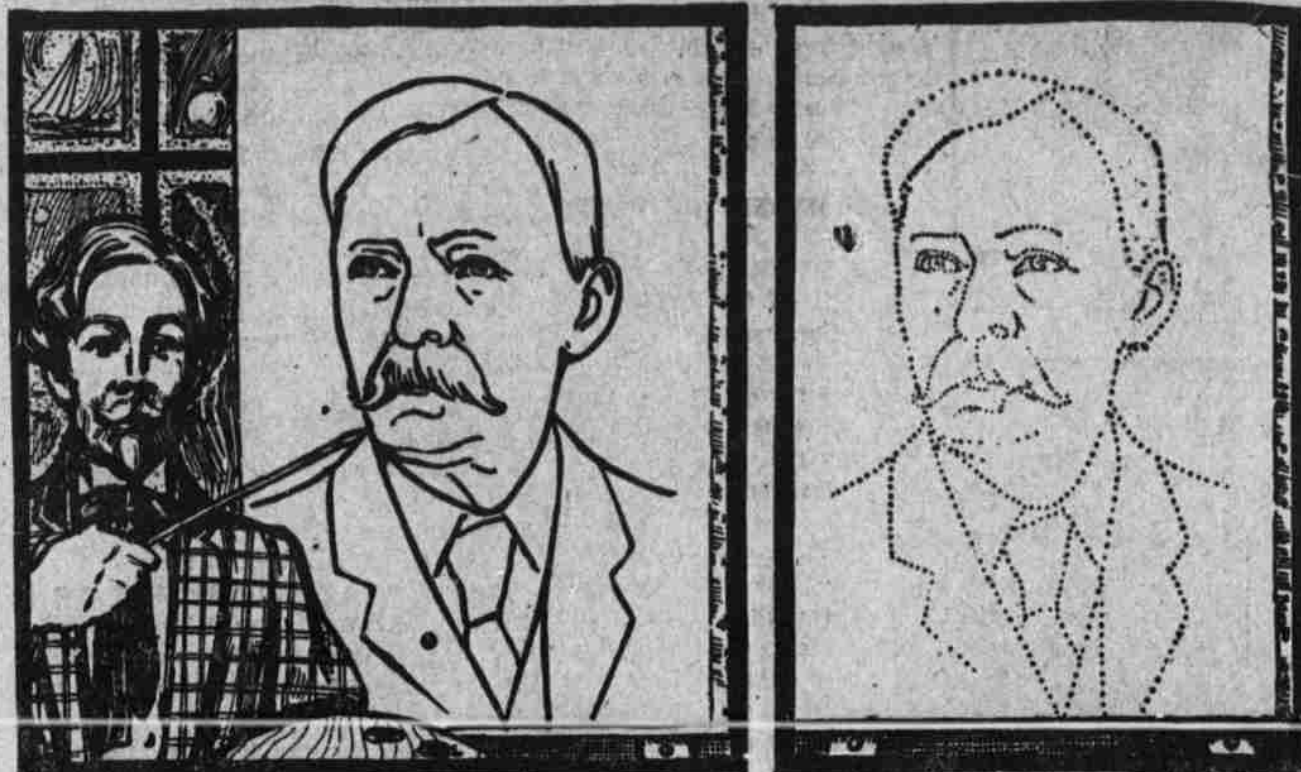
"The union of mothers of every race and creed is growing closer constantly. Even in Texas I find that no less than 800 clubs have sprung up during the last two years, and the numbers of women interested in some of the states far pass Illinois' 10,000."

Mrs. Hall says that the national organization has associated with it the societies in Mexico, Bolivia, Cuba and other foreign countries and that greater expansion probably will be announced at the Denver convention in June. An international convention is to be held at Washington next year.

The women are interested particularly in the better education of children to fit them for family responsibilities. One method is that outlined in Governor Deneen's proclamation—sermons from the church pulpits directed at the parents and also giving suggestions to the children. The other is a course in the public schools, compulsory for all, teaching the boys and girls the demands and responsibilities of parenthood. It is urged also that every church organize a motherhood society.
