ROOSEVELTS START HOME.

Many Notables Present to Wish Party Happy Journey Toward Home.

South Hampton, June 10.—Colonel Roosevelt, wife, daughter and son Kermit, sailed today for America on the steamer Kaiserine Augusta Victoria. They will arrive in New York June 18. A great crowd was at the Pier to give the party a sendoff among whom were many notable Englishmen. Roosevelt spent the night with Sir Edward Gray and went aboard early. He said, "and now for home. I tell you I am glad. I have had a great time; couldn't have been finer. I enjoyed every minute but I will be glad to get home."

WESTERN UNION INDICTED.

Accused of Supplying Data to Bucket Shops Conducted Illegally.

Washington, June 10.—A federal grand jury today returned indictments against the Western Union Telegraph company on forty-two counts on charges of having violated the laws against bucket shops on March first. Wire service of the company is alleged to have served data to Edward Altemus and Lewis Cella, who are alleged to have operated a standard grain dealers in the district of Columbia and other cities. William Price and company were also indicted, charged with operating the bucket shop.

This action follows grand jury indictments against twenty-eight brokers who are members of firms in New York, St. Louis, Cincinnati, Jersey City, Boston, Baltimore, Philadelphia, St. Louis and Washington, charging them with bucket shopping.
