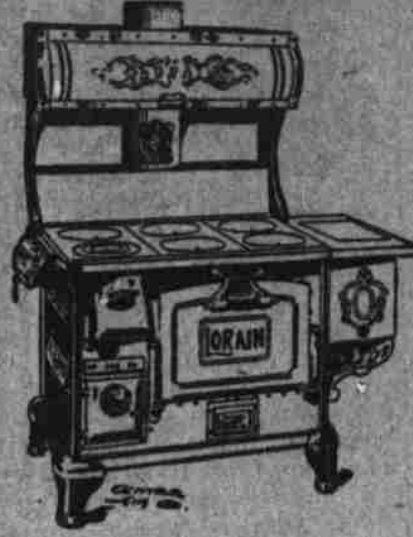
Deports His Opponent.
