NAB ELOPERS AT UNION

WALLA WALLA AND FREEWATER COUPLE ARRESTED.

Caught at Union and Bound Over to The Circuit Court Here.

A pair of young people traveling under the guise of husband and wife, were taken in tow by the city marshal Saturday at the Park mill, where they were in the employ of the Union Pine Lumber Co., says the Union Scout. The woman whose name was Alta Smith, hailed from Walla Walla, and the man R. O. Wheeler, from the Freewater district. The pair had been together about six weeks and the two-year-old daughter of the young woman was with them. The husband, B. E. Smith, located the pair after diligent search and secured a warrant for their arrest with the result that both were arraigned in the justice court of Union. The man waived examination and is held to the circuit court under a bond of \$250. At the time for arraigning the woman, her lawful husband jumped the country and she was released for lack of prosecution. After the trial of Wheeler, Smith left left town without any orders for forwarding his mail. Whether he will appear in the circuit court to prosecute the despoiler of his home can only be guessed at. The woman is remaining in the vicinity without any definite future plans. Whether the break between husband and wife can be healed over, remains to be seen. Probably

the husband will receive his wife with open arms and the future will be of another color from that of the past.
