MARVELS HOLD A LARGE CROWD IN WONDER

FEATS WITH RIFLE, SHOTGUN
PISTOLS PERFORMED

Almost Impossible Feats Cleverly Executed by Exhibitors.

Adolph Topperwein and his smiling and clever wife, two of the best shots ever seen in La Grande, yesterday gave a remarkable exhibition of their ability before a crowd of a couple of hundred people in the Foley pasture yesterday afternoon.

The Topperweins are world's champions, and in every department of the shooting game are almost unexcelled. With rifle, revolver and shotgun they entertained the enthusiasts who had gathered for over an hour, showing quite as much proficiency in going after high thrown eggs as targets with a shotgun, as they had in the close range work with the smaller weapons.

Some of their feats were startling, indeed. For instance, the husband, stalling his fingers in five empty shotgun shells, permitted the smiling lady to shoot them off with her rifle. He stood with a pipe in his mouth and she broke it. He held a card with its edge to her and

she cut it in two. She shot two revolvers simultaneously at different objects, and Topperwein did the same thing later, the while he seemed to try to stand on his head.

Bricks, marbles, baseballs, oranges, paper sacks and eggs were blown to pieces with various rifles, bullets, in rapid succession and Topperwein raising an old can from the ground, drove it in the air a distance of 30 feet with a rapid succession of rifle balls. Twirling his shotgun with one hand, Topperwein tossed two eggs in the air with the other and shot them both. Again he laid his gun on the ground, tossed the egg into the air, ran 20 feet, got his gun and broke the egg, all quicker than it takes to tell. Five eggs, thrown into the air by the husband at one time, were shot to pieces by the clever wife before they reached the ground.

In all it was a most wonderful exhibition, and it is not much wonder that it delighted Baker gun enthusiasts, for Topperwein and his wife are high guns in any company. At San Antonio, Texas, for instance, he missed only four out of 50,000 2-inch wood blocks thrown into the air, and shot at with a 22 rifle.
