

RESISTS OFFICER AND IS FINED

NIGHT OFFICER PORTER HAS A
TIME OF IT ARRESTING O'BRIEN

"Drunk and Disorderly" Prisoner
Demands Trial in Police Court.

John O'Brien sustained a fine of \$25 in the city police court this morning for resisting an officer. The resistance came last night when night Officer Porter tried to arrest him. He was finally placed in the city jail and this morning was fined by "Judge" Cox.

F. Wyatt pleaded not guilty to a charge of drunk and disorderly this morning following his arrest last night and his trial will take place this afternoon. This will be the first drunk and disorderly charge to be tried here for several months and the prisoners almost invariably plead guilty.
