HUNTERS WHO HAVE PAID LICENSE NUMBER TWO HUNDRED

Eight Hundred Have Acquired Fishing Rights. Up-to-Date.

Over 800 anglers have taken out licenses up to date from County Clerk Ed Wright. In addition to these, 200 more have acquired rights to hunt, but as the season is still a considerable time away, the hunting licenses have not been in great demand up to this time. The open season law on sage hens commenced today, but otherwise no laws are open until the 15th of August when grouse can be killed.
