**SPEAKERS URGE LAW AND ENFORCEMENT IN SPEECHES**

Music and Solos Supplement Entertaining Program Last Evening

Speeches indicating that the law and order league of this county and its supporters are in the local option campaign with a vim, were delivered at the L. D. S. tabernacle last evening before a large audience composed of members from all the churches of the city. Rev. W. S. Seemann and A. S. Geddes were the principal speakers of the evening and their addresses were augmented with few informal talks by citizens, choir music, instrumental music and a vocal solo by Mrs. A. L. Richardson.

Mr. Geddes, in his address, spoke of the need of law enforcement, but not in a vindictive manner. Personalities were not indulged in by Mr. Geddes, or by Mr. Seemann, either, who later reviewed what the league has accomplished since its existence. Perfect harmony prevailed in the meeting and with the exceptionally excellent music, the program was an entertaining one.

A counsel of ten, from which the executive committee is named and the president and secretary chosen, was elected by popular ballot. The counsel is composed of Geo. L. Cleaver, J. E. Stevenson, W. S. Seeman, E. W. Kammerer, J. W. McAllister, H. C. Vinacke, George Stoddard, C. W. Black, J. K. Wright and F. H. Green.
