Brussels, Aug. 10.—Disciples of physical culture from all over the world in attendance today at the opening session of the third International Congress on Physical Education. Dr. R. Tait MacKenzie, director of physical education of the University of Pennsylvania, is the official representative of the United States. He will deliver an address on "Physical Culture in American Colleges."

King Albert has manifested great interest in the work of the congress, and delivered a brief address of welcome at the inaugural session today. The general object of the congress is to stimulate interest in the best methods of promoting the physical, moral and intellectual well-being of children and young people.

The work of the congress is now well under way in all of the more important European nations, and an American committee has been formed to press the propaganda in the United States. Prof. M. V. O'Shea, of the University of Wisconsin, is chairman

Notice of Street Improvement.

To Whom It May Concern: Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the Common Council of the City of La Grande, Oregon on the 9th day of February, 1910, creating Improvement District No. 16 and designating Sixth street, as such district, and in pursuance of a resolution adopted by said Common Council on the 27th day of July, 1910, whereby said Council determined and declared its intention to improve all that portion of Sixth street, in said improvement district as hereinafter described, by laying thereon 5 foot cement walk, the council will, ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefitted by such improvement, order that said above described improvement be made; that the boundaries of said district to be so improved are as follows: All that portion of Sixth street, from the south side of Washington avenue, to the north side of "N" avenue. Notice is hereby further given that the Council will levy a special assessment on all the property affected and benefitted by such improvement for the purpose of paying for such improvement. That the estimated cost of such improvement is the sum of \$1718.90. That the council will on the 17th day of August, 1910, meet at the council chamber at the hour of 8 o'clock p. m., to consider said estimated cost, and the levy of said assessment, when a hearing will be granted to any person feeling aggrieved by such assessment.
