Mr. and Mrs. C. N. Lewis made a short trip to Milton last week.

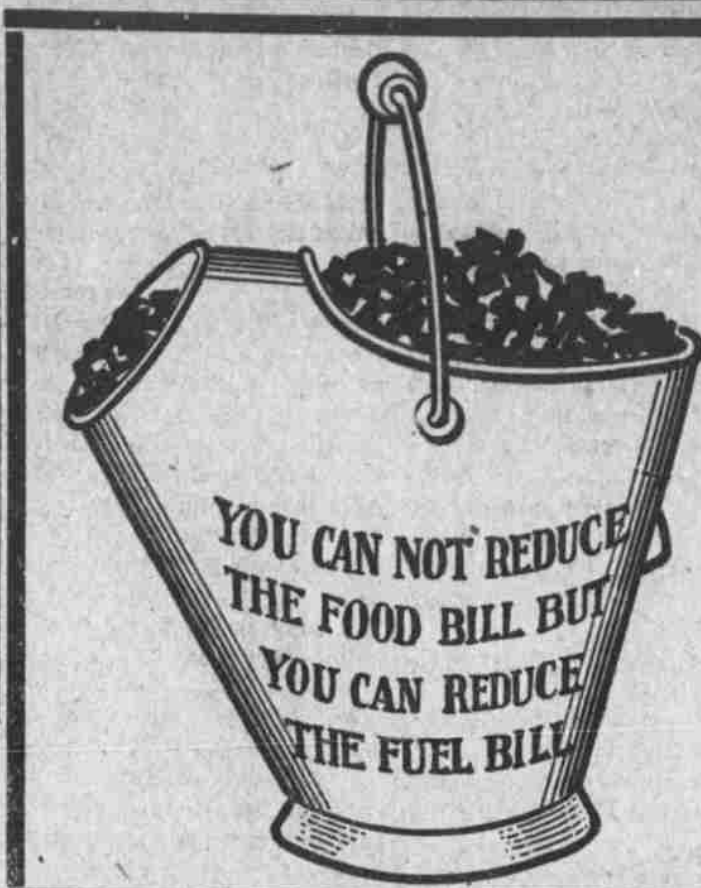
