LOCAL STREAMS ADJUDICATED

WATER COMMISSIONER NOW AT PENDLETON HEARING CASES.

Several Union County Streams Have Been Adjudicated of Late.

Pendleton, Sept. 12—F. M. Saxton, water commissioner for the eastern Oregon, district is making rapid progress with the work of adjudicating the water rights of the settlers along the different streams in his territory. He is now in Pendleton and will be for a week or ten days longer, while the claims of the different water users along the Umatilla river and its tributary streams are on file at the courthouse and being inspected by those interested.

The rights along seven streams in his territory have been adjudicated and the findings of the board of control have been filed or are ready to be filed with the proper county clerks.

Among the streams which have been adjudicated, are the following in Union county:
