It is expected that this source of revenue will add millions of dollars yearly to the wealth productions of the four states and keep at home hundreds of thousands of dollars, now snt to middle western states for pork products. Keen interest is centered in the movement in various parts of the northwest, especially in packing house centers, and it is likely that concerted action will follow the session in Spokane.

The opening of the E. H. Stanton Sommer Bldg.
