**BIG FEED TAKES PLACE TONIGHT**

**FIRE DEPARTMENT TO BE HOST TO FIRE SUFFERERS AND OTHERS.**

Banquet to be More Elaborate Than Customary Clam Bakes.

All who donated to the relief of the fire department following the fire of July 3, are urged to attend the fire department banquet this evening at 8 o'clock.—Chief of Fire Department, JOSEPH JONES.

With this urgent and warm invitation sent out to something like twenty-five or thirty business men and women who rewarded the fire department after the fire in "Dutch Town" last July, the La Grande fire department under the auspices of Rescue Hose company No. 1 will be host tonight to a large gathering of fire fighters and fire fighters' friends at the K. of P. hall. The banquet is to be a little more elaborate than those which the company frequently holds in the central hose house, and those who have received invitations are deeming themselves fortunate. It will be more formal than a clam bake and that the banquet may proceed with scheduled dispatch all the guests should be on hand promptly at 8 o'clock when festivities commence.

The chief and his department are especially anxious to have all those who donated to the department at the last fire attend this banquet as it is given especially in their honor.
