GALLOWAY MILL NEAR IMBLES TO BE MOVED.

Fine Stand of Timber on McKay Creek to be Cut This Winter.

A sawmill with a capacity of 25-3000 feet, owned by Cecil A. Galloway has been purchased by G. E. Barr and E. E. Barr of Adams Ore., and as soon as Mr. Galloway loads the mill at Imbel, it will be hauled to Menchem and again transported by team to the head of McKay creek. The new owners have a fine stand of timber in fact they claim to have the best in that country and with the Wallows mill, they are going to convert a large quantity of it into lumber this winter.

The Messrs Barr were in the city this morning, having just completed arrangements for the purchase of the big mill. Mr. Galloway will rush the work of tearing the machinery down and hauling it to Imbel.
