To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the Common Council of the City of La Grande, Oregon on the 21st day of September, 1910, creating Improvement District No. 26 and designating Cedar street as such district, and in pursuance of a resolution adopted by said Common Council on the 21st day of September, 1910, whereby said Council determined and declared its intention to improve all that portion of Cedar Street, in said improvement district, as hereinafter described, by laying thereon board sidewalk, the Council, will ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefited by such improvement, order that said above described improvements be made; that the boundaries of said district to be so improved are as follows:

All that portion of Cedar street, from the South curb line of "C" avenue, to the south curb line of "A" avenue. Notice is hereby further given that the Council will levy a special assessment on all the property affected and benefited by such improvement. That the estimated cost of such improvement is the sum of \$330.00.
