UNIVERSITY CAMPUS IS LARCE

CORRESPONDENCE COURSE SENT STUDENTS IN MANY PLACES.

Practice Carried Out by State Institution is Well Patronized.

Eugene, Ore., Oct. 21 (Special)—A university education is within the grasp of every man and woman in Oregon makes it possible for everyone to do work of equal standard to work done in residence at the university. This department was established in 1907, and since that time has grown rapidly, until now it has a registration of nearly four hundred.

The members of the university faculty prepare regular lesson assignments which are sent to the student from a central office, when the student has completed the assignment, he sends in a report, which is corrected and criticized by the instructor in that subject.

There is no cost to the student, except a deposit of one dollar for each course to cover postage. If the student so desires, he may secure regular college credit for his work. When groups of people have taken up the study of a certain subject together, members of the faculty of the university may be secured free of cost, to lecture upon that subject.

In this way the University of Oregon is able to reach over the entire state, and it is truthfully said that the University campus contains one hundred thousand square miles.

New Pacific Service.

Wellington, N. Z., Oct. 24—With the sailing from Auckland today of the first steamer in the subsidized mail service of the Union Steamship Company, New Zealand is given much better mail communication with America and England. The vessels will call at Raratonga, Cook Islands, and at Papeete, Tahiti. The time between Auckland and San Francisco will be reduced to twenty-two days, and New Zealand will reach London in thirty-two days.

Resume Work on Mine.

A force of men will resume work next week on the Mountain Gem mines, near the head of the lake. This promising property will soon be ready for machinery and is destined to become one of the great gold and copper producers of the country.—Joseph Herald.

Enterprise Fair Permanent.

The county fair board at a meeting held Thursday night, started the preliminary steps for incorporation of the permanent organization. While all the stock has not been subscribed the board has faith that the people of the county will see that it is raised and the fair put on a good footing. The premium money from the state has not yet come, but is expected the first of next week. The list of premium awards will be published in the next issue.—Enterprise News Record.
