MEXICANS ON INVASION OF TEXAS

Austin, Texas, Nov. 15—The state rangers were today ordered to go to Rock Springs, Edwards county, to repel the invasion of armed Mexicans seeking revenge for the lynching of Rodriguez, whose death is ascribed as the cause for the recent anti-American outbreaks in Mexico. Governor Campbell is awaiting definite information as to the whereabouts of the Mexicans before ordering out the militia. The governor is inclined to make light of the matter and said he knew positively that about 500 Mexican in groups of fifty and a hundred are encamped along the border. "Texas is prepared to defend her citizens," he said. Citizens of Rock Springs have been uneasy since last night when advices were received from Del Rio on the border that Mexicans contemplated an invasion.

The main body of the Texas Rangers are marching from Ovaldo to Rock Springs, Captain John Hughes commanding. He expects to arrive there at noon tomorrow.

Farmers in Brigade.

Rock Springs, Nov. 15—Eighty ranchers and cowboys left here today riding hard toward the border to intercept the 300 Mexicans marching for Las Vegas, Mexico with the avowed intention of avenging the recent lynching. Others are joining the Texans.

LIBEL SUIT IS INSTITUTED BY GAINES

A letter written by Oswald West when he was Secretary of the Oregon Railroad Commission, and published in the Observer about a year ago, is the basis for a libel suit brought by E. F. W. Gaines the rate man who has been making his headquarters in La Grande for the past two years. George Currey, now in the real estate business, but then publisher of the Observer, Governor-Elect Oswald West, and Attorney Turner Oliver are the three defendants, and the plaintiff alleges that his character has been slandered and defamed through the publication of that letter to the extent of \$20,000 and that he lost "business" to the extent of \$5,000 all of which he seeks to recover in a suit filed late yesterday afternoon.

In the letter, Mr. West advised Mr. Oliver to warn the people of Union county against signing the contracts which Mr. Gaines was at that time securing. Mr. Gaines' plan was to procure a contract with farmers to have rate reductions made, he to take half the reductions and the farmer to get the rest. It was this practice which Mr. West condemned in his letter and which Mr. Gaines basis his suit on.
