San Francisco, Dec. 8.-Domingo Navarro, president of the Ship Scalers' union was shot and instantly killed here yesterday at the Union Iron works. His slayer escaped. It is reported that the shooting resulted from a quarrel centering over the strike which the scalers are considering calling.

Later it was learned that August Inarevale, a Spaniard shot Navarro. According to Arevale he did not know that the strike was on and seeing that men were wanted he started to apply for a job, when a number of men including Navarro set upon him and struck him several times when he pulled his revolver and fired, and the crowd scattered. Arevale was arrested in hiding on the waterfront.
