In the matter of declaring the result of local option liquor election. Ordered that there is a majority of 462 votes against prohibition. Former order declaring prohibition revoked on and after Dec. 8, 1910.

In the matter of working prisoners on county road. Ordered that Thomas Bruce be worked on county road.

In the matter of opening bids for work on Burnaugh road. Continued for the term.

In the matter of the cancellation of Road Fund warrant No. 4370. Warrant ordered cancelled.

In the matter of the payment to county clerk for conducting elections. county clerk directed to draw warrant in his favor for \$100.00 for conducting elections.

In the matter of the appointment of a truant officer for school district No. 15. Joseph Orton appointed.

In the matter of the payment of steel bridges erected at Cove, Elgin and Willow Creek. Clerk directed to draw warrant on the road fund for \$2540.00, in payment of balance due for steel bridges.
