Sacramento, Feb. 11-A verbal riot in the senate this afternoon followed the introduction of a resolution calling for the recall of United States Senator John Works of Los Angeles, because he opposes the recall of the judiclary The measure was introduced by Sanford and was not read nor printed in the Journal for information of senators and Senator John Roseberry, in the chair, refused to have it read, holding that the time for allotment for introduction of "bills" had elapsed. 


