Notice of Street Improvement.

To Whom It May Concern:

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the Common Council of the City of La Grande, Oregon, on the 1st day of Dec. 1910, creating Improvement district No. 10, and designating Greenwood street, as such district, and in pursuance of a resolution adopted by said Common Council on the 18th day of January, 1911, whereby said Council determined and declared its intention to improve all that portion of Greenwood avenue, in said improvement district as hereinafter described, by laying thereon Bitulithic pavement, the Council will, ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefitted by such improvement, order that said above described improvement be made; that the boundaries of said district to be so improved are as follows:

All that portion of Greenwood street, from the west side of Adams avenue to the west side of Washington avenue.

(A) And the property affected or benefitted by said improvement is as follows:

All of block 109 and the south half of block 108, and the N. E. 1-4 of block 68, and the east half of block 100, of Chaplins Add. to La Grande, Oregon. Also the north half of block 9, of Cogans Add to La Grande, Oregon.

Notice is hereby further given that the Council will levy a special assessment on all the property affected and benefitted by such improvement for the purpose of paying for such improvement. That the estimated cost of such improvement is the sum of \$3,390.00. That the Council will on the 15th day of February, 1911, meet at the Council chamber at the hour of 8 o'clock p. m., to consider said estimated cost, and the levy of said assessment, when a hearing will be granted to any person feeling aggrieved by such assessment.
