Oregon A. C., Corvallis, Ore., Feb. 15 (Special)—The Oregon Agricultural college basketball team will play a series of games during the inter-semester vacation, touring the college towns of the Willamette valley. On Feb. 18, O. A. C. plays Willamette university in the capital city. In Portland the Beavers play Columbia university in the university gymnasium, and games are also scheduled with the Multnomah club and the Y. M. C. A.

The tour of Washington and Idaho for games with the conference colleges and others is deferred until early in March, since there were conflicting dates at the University of Idaho and Washington state college. Washington University team plays O. A. C. at Corvallis Thursday, Feb. 16. The agricultural college team is at present made up of the following men: Teddy Reed of Burns, Harney county, at left forward; Ben Cooper Corvallis, right forward; Ellis De-ment, Myrtle Point, Coos county, at center; Allen Burdick, Portland, at left guard and Claude Matson, Clatsop county at right guard.

First Notice of Association Sent Out to Newspapers Yesterday

Caldwell, Idaho, Feb. 15 (Special)—Caldwell, Idaho, has been made the national headquarters for the White Cross Home Finding society, a new movement, and the first shot was fired yesterday when the notices were sent to several of the big dailies in the northwest.

The notice reads:

"If you are a fallen woman, or nearly so, write the White Cross Home Finding Society, Caldwell, Idaho, giving your sure address and if you desire to begin a life of innocence, wait for our reply."

"If you are one of those rare husbands and wife or widow, and have that rarer environment, where you can take one of the fleeing creatures named above and make your home her home for a year or six months, even if this society will have to pay for her groceries, write the White Cross Home Finding Society, Caldwell, Idaho, having some bank endorse your application."

"If you are one of those kind persons with a little money who sympathizes with this work, become a member of the Society and send your check to the White Cross Home Finding Society, Caldwell, Idaho."

**BIRTH OCCURS IN CAR 23 AND ON THE 18TH.**

Austin Child Holds Rare Freak of Circumstances Attending Birth.

Baker, Feb. 15 (Special)—Just what birthplace, the little child, who was born to Mrs. R. Kirkland, of Austin, can claim, is a hard question to decide for the little girl was born on the Sumpter Valley train between Sumpter and this city recently.

When it became known that the stork was about to alight on the train, the car was vacated and given over to the woman and the little babe first saw the light of day as the train was passing the Bowen ranch about three miles from this car.

At South Baker, a telephone message was sent to this city and an ambulance and physician met the train, and the mother and child were taken to the hospital, where, in spite of the strange circumstances of the birth, both are doing nicely.
