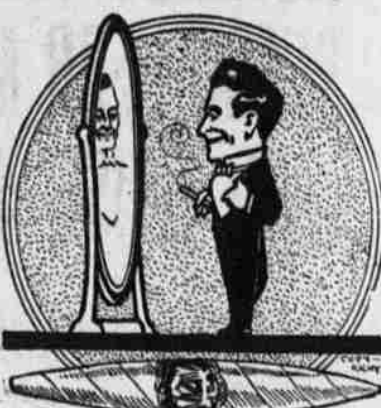
Mt. Olivet. At the morning hour he will speak of the "Loneliness of the sinner."
