The theme of the film, reduced to 2,000 feet is lassoing wild animals in Africa and Buffalo Jones is the man who does the important work for the picture. Teddy Roosevelt said himself that the hunting of Jones made his (Roosevelt's) work in the jungle look like "thirty cents." The films have been shown throughout the country the past few weeks as works of art. Manager George announces this special attraction for his patrons for early next week, believing that the public will appreciate his efforts in this line. To go back into details in describing the scenes would be a voluminous task but some of the important scenes might be titled to advantage: to the theatre goer who plans to see this great piece of art.
