Depicting East African habits and life and natural scenery, the story is worth while in itself, but it goes farther than that and tells a story of capturing wild animals that may be conceded, is not attempted by any hunter save Col. Jones. Lassoing cheetahs, hardebeest, zebra and other wild animals is tame, however, compared to the struggle with a huge rhinoceros and a well grown lioness. The former is a vicious animal that taxes the skill of the hunters and many of the men and horses have narrow escapes. Then comes the tussel with the lioness, her capture by the lassoing method, her pull up to a tree, removing her claws, and feeding her and finally unloading the big animal aboard a train and starting the beast toward the zoo at New York.

The job is dangerous and ticklish in the extreme but Jones does it nicely.

With a few minor exceptions the film is clear, though of course some of the wild chases across the prairies are rather dim, but all the animals caught are brought into close range and there is not a dull moment in the entire film of 2,000 feet, produced in two reels.
