WILL INCLUDE TRIP ACROSS THE CONTINENT.

Partisan Talks Not Announced—Will Lecture at Many Towns.

Oyster Bay, March 8.—Col. Theodore Roosevelt left here this morning for New York where he will make his start for his big speaking tour through the south and west.

Col. Roosevelt is to make the first speech of his trip tomorrow at Atlanta, where he is to address the Southern Commercial congress now in session in that city.

Declaring an investigation would set at rest "false charges" and do the church good, Joseph Smith, head of the Mormon church, today asserted he would welcome the investigation of the church and charges that young girls were persuaded to emigrate from England to the Mormon colonies of Utah.

The reports from England say that Home Secretary Winston Churchill will investigate and ascertain whether the charges of polygamy being practiced in Utah where the girls are alleged to have been sent to, are true.
