TRAIN CREW IN FIGHT.

Haines Boys Figure in Fracas With Passenger Train Crew Last Week

(Baker Herald.)

John and Marion Pierce of Haines are now in the county jail awaiting the action of the grand jury. It is alleged that they assaulted the conductor and trainmen on No. 5 Friday night while they were attempting to beat their way to Haines. The train was stopped between here and Haines and the boys put off, and it was then that the trouble occurred.

Pierce, father of the boys. made the following statement to the Herald: "In regard to the row on the train I am informed by eye witnesses that my boys are a little to blame and the train crew are more to blame.
