PREVENTION OF CONFLAGRATION ANTICIPATED.

China-Like Walls, to Carry Advertis-ing, Will Be Bullt at Once.

New York, March 23 .- (Special) --The great wall of China may soon be outdone by the great wall or rather walls of New York, for it is now proposed, as a safeguard against fire, to make the metropolis the first wall d city in the country since the days of the earliest settleemnts. This novel suggestion was put forward at a recent meeting of th: Credit Mea's associatio nat the Hotel Astor, and is now being seriously considered. It is not planned of course to wall in the whole city, but instead by the erection of transverse barriers in various localities to make impossible any general conflagration since these barriers would check the further spread of any fire. Neither is it proposed exclusive-ly to erect plain walls towering two hundred feet into the air. Whereaver it proves possible to construct a continuous line of absolutely fir proof buildings these structures will be used as a fire wall. Only where such a plan is impossible or to fill in the uncompleted gaps in such a link is it proto construct the mammoth walls. The inventor of the new idea on these barriers could easily be sold at a price sufficiently large to wipe out at an early date the cost of their construction. The chief difficulty, however, in this connection seems to lie in the fact that present bill posting methods and facilities are in no way prepared to plaster a two hundred foot high wall with work of more or less
