LADY TAKES LONG TRIP

MRS. PROPECK ACCOMPANIES HER HUSBAND FROM BEAVER

Walks 12 Miles and Rides 16 All in One Day—Snowbound Four Months

A test of strength and endurance such as few ladies could cope with was experienced yesterday by Mrs. Ed. Propeck who accompanied her husband to La Grande from their cottage at the head of the Beaver creek pipe line.

Mr. and Mrs. Propeck walked 12 miles before reaching a point where horses could be used and to top off the day's work they rode 16 miles reaching La Grande in good time and not unduly fatigued.

While Mr. Propeck has braved the elements to come to La Grande occasionally during the winter months, this is the first time that Mrs. Propeck has been away from the mountain cottage for a period of four months. The winter there is severe; four feet of snow still mantles the ground at their cottage, but aside from occasional moments of loneliness the couple enjoy their isolation.

The snow has been slow in disappearing and partly for this reason they were loath to brave the trip. There is more snow at the intake now than there was early in March last year, says Mr. Propeck. Before returning to the cottage Mrs. Propeck will meet her mother who is to come out from Nebraska soon.
