BOATHOUSE NOW NECESSARY

PLANS BEING DISCUSSED FOR COMPLETING BUILDING.

With Increased Facilities, Such a Feature Is Necessary.

With a bathing house absolutely essential, local interest now centers in how to procure sufficient funds for the erection of a suitable building at the old swimming hole at Riverside park. As the increased bathing facilities are to be open to the public as a whole it and because of the better bathing facilities it is expected that there will be a large increase to the number of people who have in years past frequented the facilities such as they were. A series of dressing rooms has or rather will become a necessity this summer and several embryo schemes are afoot for the financing of the building.

The first move towards this fund was announced today when the All Star baseball team composed of young men just out of or now in the high school, said they are desirous of playing Union or some other team with the understanding that the funds are to go to the bathing house.
