**HYDROPLANE AT ASTORIA.**

Glenn Curtiss Will Bring Famous Machine to Astoria.

Portland, March 28.—(Special)—People of the Pacific northwest expect to have a chance to see the Curtiss hydroplane at the Astoria centennial, for contracts have been signed between the management of the exposition and Glenn Curtiss. He agrees to bring his machine to Astoria during the last week in August and give a number of exhibition flights.

The hydroplane is the machine that rises from the surface of the water and wings its way about in the air, finally coming to rest again like a huge waterfowl upon the river or lake above which it flies. The Columbia at Astoria offers ideal conditions for such flights, which will be the first ever given in the northwest by the hydroplane. This machine is supported in the water by pontoons which take the place of the wheels that serve as feet for the aeroplane.

The hydroplane skims along the surface of the water for some distance before it attains sufficient momentum to rise into the air and the contract with Curtiss calls for a speed of 35 miles an hour on the surface of the river for several miles before the actual flight begins. The aviator will then circle the Astoria harbor, make a detour over the city and then fly westward ten miles to the ocean and return to the starting point. Successful flights by the new hydroplane, the latest thing in flying machines, are guaranteed by Mr. Curtiss who will send an experienced birdman to Astoria and in addition, a regular aeroplane of the Curtiss type will be circling about Astoria during the centennial.

**BODINSON HONORED.**

Baker Man to Help Pick a Site for Oregon Building at Fair.

Governor West has honored an Eastern Oregon man, by naming F. P. Bodinson, president of the Baker commercial club and Citizen's National bank, as a member of the committee to select a site for the Oregon building at the Panama-Pacific exposition at San Francisco in 1915, states the Democrat.

In the selection of Governor West not only has distinction been shown the man, but Baker takes pride in the selection of Mr. Bodinson, as being a fitting recognition to his prominence in the business world and public life of Eastern Oregon.

The other members of the committee are Julius Meier of the firm of Meier & Frank of Portland and W. W. Travis, an attorney of Eugene.

The Oregon building at the fair will be in keeping with the buildings of other states at the Lewis and Clark exposition. The appropriation made by the legislature in 1913 after which time the committee will visit the exposition grounds at San Francisco and make a selection of a site.

**PORTUGUESE REACH BAKER.**

Sisters Arrive to Take Up New Work in Eastern Oregon.

Six Dominican sisters of the Catholic church arrived in this city Saturday night from Portugal where they have been some time carrying on their work, relates the Baker Herald. They were forced to leave Portugal because of the unsettled conditions and came to Baker upon the invitation of Bishop O'Reilly. They left last evening for Ontario where they will look over the sites for the establishment of a hospital. The people of Ontario have raised \$10,000 for the erecting of such an institution and the church will contribute a like amount. The sisters will visit other cities in Eastern Oregon before they are given definite assignments by Bishop O'Reilly for their work in this part of the state. Some of the sisters will engage in teaching and others will take up hospital work. They are well qualified for their positions, having been trained in England and Ireland.
