'TREAT' RANGES WITH TREES

WENAHU FOREST RESERVE TO
BE CARED FOR.

Government Rangers Are Ready to
Take Up the Work at Once.

To conserve the snows of the Blue
mountains in the Wenaha forest re-
serve, the government forestry bur-
eau is planning to "treat" thousands
of acres with shrubbery and trees this
summer. According to an announce-
ment that has just been made public,
camps are already being established,
where forces of government rangers
and assistants will be quartered this
summer to do the work.

The sheep ranges vacated a year
ago as a preliminary to this policy,
will be planted to trees shrubs and
the dormant springs will be devel-
oped.

This is the result of the falling off
in volume of the waters of the streams
of the reserve which have fallen off
half within the last two decades, ac-
cording to figures made public. More
water has been steadily demanded by
irrigation of lands in the valleys,
through which the streams flow, and
petitions sent to the government have
been promptly notice and complied
with.

This will give double the water sup-
ply during the summer, it is believed,
when the treatment of the mountain
forests and watersheds is completed.
The snows of the winter, instead of
melting with a rush in early spring,
will be protected during that period,
and the water saved until midsummer,
when it is really needed.

Curriculum and Its Adaptability to
Life and Living." One hundred farm-

borers have been invited to join with
educators in this conference.

day session will be James L. Hughes,
Toronto, Canada; W. H. Weir, New
York City; A. P. Hollis, Valley City,
N. Dak.; Samuel Stern recently from
China, and Col. Theodore Roosevelt,
who is making a tour of the west.

all lectures free.
