Miss In z Knowles entertained the Omae gorls, a young ladies' club composed of co-eds of the nigh school, on Thursday evening of this week.


The bi-weekly meeting of the La Jaunesse club occured this week and Mrs. H. M. Bay was the hostess. Onecours; refreshments were sered.






