**BOWLING MATCH BY WIRE**

**PORTLAND, ORE., AND HALF DOZEN TOWNS COMPETE.**

**Bowlers From All Over the Country to Compete in Event.**

New York, April 21.—Details have been completed for the telegraphic bowling contest between New York, Chicago, Cleveland, Pittsburg, Seattle, Montreal and Portland, Ore., for the Thompson trophy, donated by the president of the New York Athletic club. The tournament is to be held tomorrow and if successful will be made an annual affair.

Teams will consist of five men, with two substitutes allowed. Each club will bowl on its own alleys, which must be regulation size. The western teams will begin bowling at 7 o'clock, eastern time; the middle west teams at 9 o'clock and the eastern teams at 10 o'clock. The first five frames and the total score of each game are to be telegraphed to the different clubs connecting.

**FREIGHT TRAINS NUMEROUS**

**BUSINESS RESUMING A BETTER AVERAGE.**

**Railroad Circles Show More Activity After Brief Lull in Traffic.**

Freight business on the O. W. is resuming a standard more near the normal. Business has been dull during the several months just passed, not only here but all over the west. Of late there has been a stronger run of trains in and out of La Grande indicating a speedier return to the normal conditions that was expected. Retrenchment of expenses in the round house and machine shops is still the order all along the Harriman system, yet it is believed this will last but a month or two longer.

**Repairing Patent Floor.**

Belgium blocks, laid in bitumen, are being used to replace the faulty places in the round house floor. The floor in that building has given considerable trouble, principally because of the filling under the foundation for the floor and it is a frequent occurrence to have to replace the blocks.

**Four Engines in Shops.**

Four engines, shopped several days ago, are nearing the point where they can be turned out for service again. Aside from these the usual service repairs is all that occupies the attention of the crews.

**Passenger Crews Held Here.**

On account of the trouble near Shoshone the day before yesterday, the passenger crew on No. 17, arriving last night shortly before 9 o'clock, was held here to give the required rest and a freight crew took the passenger on to Pendleton, bringing No. 6 in this morning. The passenger conductor and brakemen had in the meantime gotten their rest and took No. 6 on to Huntington, being back again on the regular running schedule.
