Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a resolution adopted by the common council of the city of La Grande, Oregon, on the 5th day of June, 1910, creating Sewer Improvement District No. 1 and designating boundaries of Sewer District No. 1, as such district, and in pursuance of a resolution adopted by said common council on the 12th day of April, 1911, whereby said council determined and declared its intention to improve all that portion of said district, in said sewer improvement district as herein-after described, by laying sewers in the streets and alleys, the council will, ten days after the service of this notice upon the owners of the property affected and benefitted by such improvement, order that said above described improvement be made; that the boundaries of said district to be so improved are as follows:
