Literary Treasures at Auction.

New York, April 24.—The sale of the great library collected by the late Robert Hoe, to which book collectors and dealers throughout the world have been looking forward with eager interest, was commenced today at the rooms of the Anderson Auction company in this city. The library comprises 16,000 books and manuscripts and it is expected the sale will bring the highest aggregate totals of any collection ever sold at auction, not only in America, but in the world. The most notable work in the collection is the celebrated Gutenberg bible, the first book printed from movable type, and probably the best vellum copy that will ever be offered for sale. It is in two volumes in contemporary oak boards, covered with pigskin. This famous work was sold in London 14 years ago for \$20,000 and those familiar with such books place its valuation today at no less than \$40,000.

New York, April 24.—The demand for tickets indicates that the capacity of Carnegie Hall will be tested to the utmost tomorrow night to accommodate the thousands of persons who desire to attend the great tercentenary bible celebration. Bishop Greer will preside at the meeting and letters from President Taft and King George will be read. The noted speakers will include Dr. Francis L. Patton of the Princeton Theological seminary, Bishop Henry W. Warren of Denver and Dr. William Lyon Phelps of Yale university.

LA GRANDE NOW THE CHAMPS

COUNTY HONORS GO TO LOCAL TRACK MEN.

Meet Won Handily Though Cave Takes the Relay Race and Cup.

La Grande walked away with the annual county meet last Saturday in easy fashion. The old standbys of the local squad were aided by new timber, the most promising of which was Conkey, a boy of 14 or 15 summers who vaulted nine feet, six inches and who ran a splendid lap in the relay race.

La Grande lost the relay by a narrow margin. Bolton took the lead and maintained it nicely; Irwin kept up the margin, while Conkey increased it slightly. Johnson of Cove overtook Millering, however, after one of the finest spurts of speed seen on the field.

All races were close—extremely so, in fact, and it was necessary to use extreme care in picking the winners. The Elgin team did not score and as it is the first time that school has been presented, the showing is not at all bad. The Elgin youngsters ran the winners close frequently. The winners follow:
