MOTION MADE TO MAKE COMPLAINT MORE SPECIFIC.

Gaines' Libel Action Against West, Currey and Oliver Up Today.

Another brief chapter in the string of events following the bringing of action by F. W. Gaines to collect \$25,000 libel money from Governor Oswald West, George H. Currey and Attorney Turner, was written this morning when the governor and Mr. Currey through attorneys argued a motion to make more plain and certain the allegation in the complaint, filed some time ago.

Various arguments and motions have been heard in circuit court on this case during the past several months and it was believed that the case would come to a final hearing this month. Attorney Mount of Baker represented Mr. West and J. D. Slater represents Mr. Currey.

Two hundred acres of cultivated land and 218 acres of pasture land combined with some stock and private property owned by the heirs of the late Horace Williams were sold today through the Black real estate office to Fred Zaugg, a Canadian. The deal involves \$20,500.

The place lies only about four miles from La Grande.
